Admission to a Post-Secondary Diploma or Post Graduate Certificate Program

Post-Secondary Diploma Program

Academic Requirements

Scanned original copy along and/or notarized English translated copies of the following:

- Proof of graduation from a secondary institution
- Proof of academic transcripts from a secondary institution
- One of the following:
 - General Certificate of Education (0 Level) with a minimum grade of 65% or a grade of C or higher in required program subjects, OR
 - Caribbean Secondary Education Certificate (CXC) with a minimum grade of three or higher in required program subject
- Include transcripts for any post-secondary courses or programs completed.

Other Requirements

Minimum grade requirements may vary for some programs. Subject to competition, applicants may be required to present averages/grades above the minimum. Some programs may have additional requirements such as pre-admission testing, submission of a portfolio (cover letter, curriculum vitae (CV), and professional reference letters).
