# Admission to a Post-Secondary Diploma or Post Graduate Certificate Program

### **Post-Secondary Diploma Program**

#### **Academic Requirements**

#### Scanned original copy along and/or notarized English translated copies of the following:

- Proof of graduation from a secondary institution
- Proof of academic transcripts from a secondary institution
- Minimum grade of C6 for at least 5 subjects/courses, including required programs subjects (English for BG, BSM and BA and English/Math for CP) in the West African Senior Secondary School Certificate Exam (WAEC) or General Certificate of Education 0 Levels or A Levels with a minimum grade of four in English.
- Senior School Certificate awarded by the National Examinations Council (NECO) (must be accompanied by a Scratch Card\*) with a minimum grade of six (C6) in required program subjects
- Include transcripts for any post-secondary courses or programs completed, including
- Higher National Diploma and National Diploma (degrees must be awarded in First Class or Second Class: Upper or Lower Division)

## **Other Requirements**

- Minimum grade requirements may vary for some programs. Subject to competition, applicants may be required to present averages/grades above the minimum.
- Some programs may have additional requirements such as pre-admission testing, submission of a portfolio (cover letter, curriculum vitae (CV), and professional reference letters). Please refer to the program website for details.

## **Graduate Certificate Program**

#### **Academic Requirements**

#### Scanned original copy along with notarized English translated copies of the following:

- Proof of graduation of a post-secondary institution
- Proof of academic transcripts from a post-secondary institution Higher Diploma and Higher National Diploma are no longer accepted for GC programs.
