Admission to a Post-Secondary Diploma or Post Graduate Certificate Program

Post-Secondary Diploma Program

Guyana is exempt from providing proof of English.

Academic Requirements

Scanned original copy along with notarized English translated copies of the following:

- Proof of graduation from a secondary institution
- Proof of academic transcripts from a secondary institution
- General Certificate of Education (GCE) and/or Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination/CXC with a minimum grade of three or C in required program subjects
- Proof of academic transcripts for any post-secondary courses or programs completed

Other Requirements

- Minimum grade requirements may vary for some programs. Subject to competition, applicants may be required to present averages/grades above the minimum.
- Some programs may have additional requirements such as pre-admission testing, submission of a portfolio (cover letter, curriculum vitae (CV), and professional reference letters). Please refer to the website of the program you are applying to for details.

- Proof of graduation from a post-secondary institution
- Proof of academic transcripts from a post-secondary institution (depending on program of interest)
