Admission to a Post-Secondary Diploma or Post Graduate Certificate Program

Post-Secondary Diploma Program

Academic Requirements

Scanned original copy along with notarized English translated copies of the following:

- One of the following:
 - West African Senior School Certificate must be accompanied by a Scratch Card/General Certificate of Education 0 Levels or A Levels with a minimum grade of six (C6) in required program subjects
 - Senior School Certificate awarded by the National Examinations Council (NECO) must be accompanied by a Scratch Card with a minimum grade of six (C6) in required program subjects
- Include transcripts for any post-secondary courses or programs completed
 (degrees must be awarded in First Class or Second Class: Upper or Lower Division)

Other Requirements

- Minimum grade requirements may vary for some programs. Subject to competition, applicants may be required to present averages/grades above the minimum.
- Some programs may have additional requirements such as pre-admission testing, submission of a portfolio (cover letter, curriculum vitae (CV), and professional reference letters). Please refer to the program website for details
 - WAEC Certificates must be accompanied by a Scratch Card or Scratch Card details, in order to verify your results online through WAECDIRECT. To use WAECDIRECT to verify WAEC information, we require a copy of your WASSCE results, as well as the Card Serial Number and Personal Identification Number (PIN) that appear on the Scratch Card. Scratch Cards can be purchased at the National Office of WAEC or at WAEC branches.

Academic Requirements

Scanned original copy along with notarized English translated copies of the following:

- Proof of graduation of a post-secondary institution (degrees must be awarded in First Class or Second Class: Upper or Lower Division)
- Proof of academic transcripts from a post-secondary institution (depending on program of interest)
