Admission to a Post-Secondary Diploma or Post Graduate Certificate Program

Post-Secondary Diploma Program

Academic Requirements

Scanned original copy along with notarized English translated copies of the following:

- Proof of graduation from a secondary institution
- Proof of academic transcripts from a secondary institution
- Include transcripts for any post-secondary courses or programs completed.

Other Requirements

- Minimum grade requirements may vary for some programs. Subject to competition, applicants may be required to present averages/grades above the minimum.
- Some programs may have additional requirements such as pre-admission testing, submission of a portfolio (cover letter, curriculum vitae (CV), and professional reference letters). Please refer to the program website for details.

Graduate Certificate Program

Academic Requirements

Scanned original copy along with notarized English translated copies of the following:

- Proof of graduation of a post-secondary institution
- Degree or college diploma and transcripts (depending on program of interest)

Proof of English Proficiency (All programs)

- Students who graduated after 2011 are exempt from POE.
- Students who graduated High School prior to 2011 can provide the following to meet the language requirements:





- 1. Supporting letter that outlines Medium of Instruction (MOI). MOI must be provided for the required level for the program in question. MOI could be from **secondary school for diploma** or **post-secondary level for post-graduate** programs. MOI duration is dependent on the credential from which it was obtained. MOIs provided from High School studies for Diploma programs, must cover the 4 years of study in High School. If the MOI is provided from PSEC studies and is for a Graduate program, minimum of 2 years is required. Proof of graduation is not required for POE purposes. Please note, proof of graduation is still mandatory to meet academic requirements.
- 2. Transcript from a post-secondary education after 2011. Graduation certificate is only required if student is applying for a graduate program. If student is applying for Diploma program, graduation certificated is not needed, but 2 years' worth of study in English is required.
- 3. In cases whereby MOI cannot be provided, proof of English Language Proficiency (POE/ELP) in the form of English Language testing (ex. IELTS, PTE, etc.) can be accepted as per standard admission requirement guidelines (Language Proficiency | Niagara College Toronto).

Note – Students applying for Diploma programs with post-secondary education documents only are still required to have English/ Native Language with a minimum grade of 50%.
